Formal Structure

Parliament: of the Association consists of all its members.

Parliament is responsible for:

- 1) the plan and program of work;
- 2) adopt the Statute, as well as amendments to the Statute;
- 3) adopt other general acts of the Association;
- 4) appoint and dismiss members of the Management Board;
- 5) consider and approve, at least annually, a report of the Management Board;
- 6) review and adopt the financial plan and report;
- 7) decide about status changes and dissolution of the Association;
- 8) decide about joining alliances and other Associations in the country and abroad.

MANAGEMENT BOARD

The Management Board is the executive body of the Association, which ensures implementation of the objectives established in this Statute.

The Management Board **has three members elected by the Parliament.**

The mandate of the members of the Board shall be three years and may be reappointed to the same position. The Governing Board from among its members elect the president and vice president.

EDUCATIONAL BOARD

- 1) Is in charge for all educational issues. Has Three members: two senior trainers and one member of Parliament –junior trainer. Senior trainers: Jana Damjanov and Lidija Vasiljevic and the board member is Neda Mirilovic
- 2) organizes regular activities of the Association;
- 3) assigns specific tasks to individual members;
- 4) make financial decisions;

5) decide to initiate the procedure for amending the Statute, on its own initiative or at the request of at least 2 members of the staff.

SUPERVISORY BOARD controls the financial operations of the Association and the observed irregularities, without delay, inform the Board of Directors. The Supervisory Board has three members elected by the Parliament. The term of office of Supervisory Board members shall be four years and may be re-elected. Board reports on every session of the Parliament. Members of the supervisory board are: Maja Milic, Jelena Milic, Karolina Veres.

Scientific and research BOARD Organises conferences, seminars and coordinates cooperation with other organisation's programmes and initiatives. It also initiates research projects and theoretical inputs.

History:

RAIP - <http://raip.edu.rs> Regional Association for Psychodrama and Integrative Psychotherapy is a psychodrama training organization located in Belgrade, Serbia. It was founded in 2009, and it provides psychodrama trainings in Bosnia, Serbia Slovenia. Main trainers of the organization are PhD Lidija Vasiljevic, BPA psychodrama trainer and supervisor, and MSc Jana Damjanov, BPA trainer and supervisor. Both Lidija and Jana were trained to become trainers and supervisors in psychodrama with Peter Haworth, senior BPA trainer and supervisor. They were collaborating for almost 10 years with OSPIP (Oxford School for Psychodrama and Integrative Psychotherapy - www.ospip.co.uk). They started biannual conference for trainees called Regional conference with the help and mentoring of Peter Haworth and Nancy Piercy, both senior BPA trainers. Also, Gordon Parrot, BPA psychodrama practitioner was coming to the conferences. RAIP also helped establishing the beginning of Body Psychodramatic Work training in Serbia, run by Susan Aaron. Now, RAIP has more than 60 trainees, 11 certified psychodrama practitioners, and almost the same number near ending their training and 3 assistant trainers (psychodrama trainers in training).

We also have a strong collaboration with our colleague from Greece – Nikos Takkis, who is also psychodrama trainer, and with whom we started meeting last year for intervision and discussions about development of our training programs, improving sociopsychodrama as method and philosophy. He is one of our invited trainers, as well as Peter Haworth and Monika Vestberg.

Monica Vestberg is coming this year for RAIP biannual conference to work with RAIP trainees and to run a preconference workshop.

RAIP is also a member of national umbrella organization called "The Union of Psychotherapeutic Associations of Serbia" - sdpt.org. Trainees can choose whether they want to qualify as psychodrama psychotherapists and/or to integrate some of the modules which are offered within RAIP.
