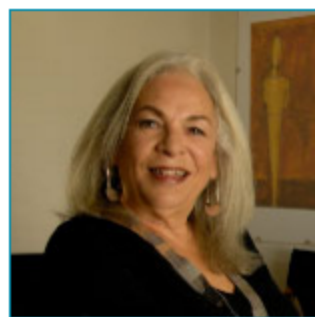


May 20 - 21 2017: **Sexuality and Gender**
